Do not need to map the exact location</li> <li>9) Make sure to get a few assets mapped before the breakout session ends</li> </ol> <p><b>Message to send to breakout rooms:</b></p> <p><b>Step 1, STICKIES:</b> Start with first category (Schools). Review stickies already in that category with group. Ask questions related to that category. Place new stickies in the category, if any. Get low-hanging fruit, then move on to the next category.
